Students work with industry professionals to put on a music theatre show in a week. The week includes acting, singing and dancing with a Director, Choreographer and Musical Director. The grand finale is a funfilled performance on stage, fully lit and in costumes for an invited audience of friends and family. Always an exciting week!

SENIOR WORKSHOP 8-16yo 'SCENES, SONGS & ROUTINES from your FAVOURITE MUSICALS'

Work with industry professionals to learn scenes, songs and routines from some of your favourite musicals. All culminating in a final performance for family and friends.

STAGE KIDS WORKSHOP 4-7yo 'PUT ON A SHOW IN A WEEK'

Similar to the Senior workshop but running for two hours per day for five days. The week includes lots of fun, dancing, singing and drama activities. All children will be involved in a performance on the final day of an age-appropriate musical. All children receive a costume and script. The final shows are always gorgeous and the children (and parents) finish the week on a high.
